2) Registration

All competitors have to make an entry in writing by an “electronic” entry form available on the web site
<https://participate.redbull.com/.....>

Registrations will become valid once the:

- the entry form has been signed, at Administrative Control on site.
- the competitor has signed the possible disclaimers during Administrative Control



3) Administrative Control

Administrative Control will take place on **July 7th, 11:00** at **Hotel**
located at **LOCALITA' VAL DI LUCE / ABETONE.**

All competitors have to submit:

- International or National License with start permission
- During Administrative Control, transponders and mounting instructions will be distributed (deposit)

4) Technical Control

Technical Control will take place on **July 7th, 11:15** at **Hotel**
located at **LOCALITA' VAL DI LUCE / ABETONE.**

4.1) Street Legality / Tires

The event **REDBULL ABESTONE HARD ENDURO** will take place exclusively on private land.

- Motorcycles do not have to be street legal
- must have a light mask mounted in the front
- homologated Enduro tires a permitted, tires shall be available to the public
- Trial tires are strictly forbidden



5) Event Format

5.1) Friday Practice Day

Location: Val di Luce

Schedule:

Free practice, sighting lap of Sunday Final B: 15:00 – 18:00 (open for all competitors)

Info: Track walking of FINAL A sections is also allowed

5.2) Saturday: Qualifying Day (Qualification for Main Race)

5.2.1) Qualifying 1&2 – “Q1 and Q2”

Location: Val di Luce

Track:

The lap for **Q1 and Q2** will be approximately 9 km long.

Format:

The track can be entered two (2) times in the morning, Q1 and two (2) times in the afternoon, Q2, according to fixed, individual starting times. One (1) timed lap in Q1 and one (1) timed lap in Q2 is mandatory.

Schedule:

- FIM-Competitors will open the qualifying sessions, followed by Amateurs.
The track can be entered two (2) times, according to fixed, individual starting times.

Starting Order:

First FIM Riders – in order of the championship standings of the actual season.
Afterwards – in order of last years Red Bull Abestone results. If a rider has not participated in 2022 in Red Bull Abestone, he will be ranked at the end of the second group, in the order of his starting number (number based on date of registration).



Start:

FIM - Competitors will start individually with twenty (20) seconds distance in order of their starting numbers.

NON FIM - Competitors will start individually with ten (10) seconds distance in order of their starting numbers.

Starting times are spread over the entire session to provide equal chances in terms of possibly changing track- and weather- conditions.

Classification:

The sum of the best single lap time of **Q1** and the best single lap time of **Q2**, determines the classification of the qualifying.

Top 30 from Saturday are qualified for the
All other competitors are qualified for the

LIQUI MOLY FINAL A.
MITAS FINAL B.

All riders who were not able to finish at least one lap in either qualifying session (Q1 or Q2), will be ranked behind all riders who were able to do so. The ranking between those riders will be according to their qualifying lap time.

5.3) Sunday: Main Race

Sunday will be divided in Final B and Final A.

Top 30 from Saturday are qualified for the **LIQUI MOLY FINAL A**, all other competitors will start in the **MITAS FINAL B**.

5.3.1) Mitas Final B

Saturday's thirty-first (31st) qualified rider and all competitors qualified behind him will compete in the **MITAS FINAL B**.

Starting at **8:30 on Sunday** competitors will start individually, **one (1) rider, every 10 seconds**, in the order of their qualifying results (best qualified first).

Location: Val di Luce

Track:

The **MITAS FINAL B** race track will be approximately **10 km** long will have one Assistance Area, at the paddock.

It will include Hard Enduro EASY – MEDIUM sections.

In not taped areas you have to stay inside a corridor of **10 m** of the intended race track. The Track is marked with tape, colored arrows and painted dots.

Start:

Start will be at **08:30**, the competitors will start individually one (1) rider **every 10 seconds**, in the order of their qualifying results (best qualified first).

Outside Help:

No outside help is allowed, neither from public nor from team members. Only riders can help each other.



Duration:

Race time stop after **2h 30min**.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the two **2h 30min** will determine the classification.

Premature Race Stop:

If, by any motive, the race must be stopped, classification will be done as follows:

Less than half of the checkpoints raced – Race will be cancelled/Null

More than half of the checkpoints raced – Results will be determined by the number of checkpoints reached in the fastest time.

Classification:

Final results will be determined considering **most laps** and by the **number of checkpoints** reached in the fastest time.

All results will be available on a live timing platform.

5.3.2) LIQUI MOLY Final A

Saturday's top **thirty (30)** qualified riders are qualified for the **LIQUI MOLY FINAL A** starting at **13:00** on Sunday.

Location: Abetone top station of Gondola (1953 slm.)

Track:

The race track will be approximately **20 km** long and will have one Assistance Area.

In not taped areas you have to stay inside a corridor of **10 m** of the intended race track. The Track is marked with tape, colored arrows and painted dots.

Start:

All competitors will start individually (one after another) with **10 s between each rider**, according to their position of their Saturday

Outside Help:

No outside help is allowed, neither from public nor from team members. Only riders can help each other.

Assistance Area:

In the assistance area teams can refuel the bike, change wheels and tires, and change all not-marked parts. **10 min** mandatory stopping for all competitors.

Refuel Area:

1 refuel point is provided on each lap. **5 min** mandatory stopping for all competitors.

GPS-Tracking:

If a checkpoint is missing the rider will be classified with the last checkpoint correctly passed. If a rider doesn't deliver the GPS at the end of the race, he will be invoiced 300 euro for the device.



Duration plan A:

2 laps

Rider that crosses first the finish line of the second lap is the Winner.

Maximum race time will be five (5) hours.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the five (5) hours will determine the classification.

Duration plan B (in case of bad weather):

1 lap

Rider that crosses first the finish line of the first lap is the Winner.

Maximum race time will be five (5) hours.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the five (5) hours will determine the classification.

Premature Race Stop:

If, by any motive, the race must be stopped, classification will be done as follows:

Less than half of the checkpoints raced – Race will be cancelled/Null

More than half of the checkpoints raced – Results will be determined by the number of checkpoints reached in the fastest time.

Classification:

Final results will be determined considering the number of Laps (2) PLAN A and Plan B one (1) lap and checkpoints reached. The rider with the most valid laps and checkpoint registrations in the right order and in the least amount of time will be the winner.

6.1) Flower Ceremony

Will take place ASAP (10 min) after the finish of the 3rd placed rider at **Paddock VAL DI LUCE**

6.2) Official Prize-Giving

Earliest 30 min after the official result has been published.

Will take place on approx. **July 9th ,18:30** at **Paddock at VAL DI LUCE**
