# <u>ANNOUNCEMENT</u>

The organizer, **IHE SRLS**, will promote a round of the 2022 FIM Hard Enduro World Championship on behalf of the **Federazione Motociclistica Italiana (FMI)**. The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with the relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions approved by the FIM International Jury.

## Supplementary Regulations: RedBull Abestone Hard Enduro 2022

FIM Enduro World Championship License Holders competing for FIM Hard Enduro World Championship points in the above event are forced to act in accordance with:

- Supplementary Regulations as following

# 3) Administrative Control

# 4) Technical Control

Technical Control will take place on July 8th, 11:15 at Hotel

located at LOCALITA' VAL DI LUCE / ABETONE.

# 4.1) Marked Parts

All competitors have to submit their motorcycle prepared according to the **FIM Technical Rules Hard Enduro 2022**. Following parts will be marked:

- Frame (right hand steering head)
- Crankcase (right or left side)
- Silencer (on the top)

Marked parts must be used throughout the entire competition and must be in their proper place at the final examination.

#### 4.2) Sound Control

Sound Control will be done based on "2mMax Method".

Sound limits are:

- 114 dB/A ahead of race,
- 115 dB/A after the race.

Each rider or his mechanic can present a maximum of one (1) motorcycle and one (1) spare silencer. Should damage or deterioration occur to the original silencer it may be changed for the marked silencer without penalty.

# 4.3) Street Legality / Tires

The event **REDBULL ABESTONE HARD ENDURO** will take place exclusively on private land.

- Motorcycles do not have to be street legal
- must have a light mask mounted in the front
- homologated Enduro tires a permitted, tires shall be available to the public
- Trial tires are strictly forbidden

# 5) Event Format

# 5.1) Friday Practice Day

Location: Val di Luce

Schedule:

Free practice: 15:00 – 18:00 (open for all competitors)

# 5.2) Saturday: Qualifying Day (Qualification for Main Race)

# 5.2.1) **Qualifying 1&2 – "Q1 and Q2"**

Location: Val di Luce

Track:

The lap for Q1 and Q2 will be approximately 15 km long.

#### Format:

The track can be entered two (2) times in the morning, Q1 and two (2) times in the afternoon, Q2, according to fixed, individual starting times. One (1) timed lap in Q1 and one (1) timed lap in Q2 is mandatory.

## Schedule:

Q1:

Lap1 Start time for first rider: 9:00Lap2 Start time for first rider: 11:00

Q2:

Lap1 Start time for first rider:Lap2 Start time for first rider:13:0015:00

- FIM-Competitors will open the qualifying sessions, followed by Amateurs. The track can be entered two (2) times, according to fixed, individual starting times.

#### Start:

Competitors will start individually with ten (10) seconds distance in order of their starting numbers. Starting times are spread over the entire session to provide equal chances in terms of possibly changing track- and weather- conditions. Details see below under section/point 12 "FIM Event Schedule".

### Classification:

**The sum** of the best single lap time of **Q1** and the best single lap time of **Q2**, determines the classification of the qualifying.

Top16 riders are qualified for the Straight Rhythm in the evening.

**Top 30** from Saturday are qualified for the All other competitors are qualified for the MITAS FINAL B.


## 5.2.2) Straight Rhythm - "JUST1 STRAIGHT RHYTHM"

20:00 Rider meeting immediately followed by timed runs

- Riders from P1 to P16 from Qualifying
- 16 Total Riders
- o Riders placed into brackets for head-to-head racing.
- The Sunday Final A starting order for the top 16 riders will be based on the Straight Rhythm results. Riders eliminated in the same round will be ranked by qualifying times.
- Pairs of riders race up to three times. Top seeded rider picks left or right lane for race one, riders switch sides for race two. If there is a tie, the lower seeded rider picks the lane for the run-off race. The winner of each bracket moves on to the next round.

# Bracket racing starts and runs in following order:

Round of 16 (16 Riders, 8 Groups of 2). Round of 8 (8 Riders, 4 Groups of 2). Semifinals (4 Riders, 2 Groups of 2). Race for P3 (P2 of Semifinal 1 & 2) Finals

# 5.3) Sunday: Main Race

Sunday will be divided in Final B and Final A.

Top 30 from Saturday are qualified for the **LIQUI MOLY FINAL A**, all other competitors will start in the **MITAS FINAL B**.

#### 5.3.1) Mitas Final B

Saturday's thirty-first (31<sup>st</sup>) qualified rider and all competitors qualified behind him will compete in the **MITAS FINAL B**.

Starting at **09:00 on Sunday** competitors will start individually, **one (1) rider, every 10 seconds**, in the order of their qualifying results (best qualified first).

Location: Val di Luce

#### Track:

The **MITAS FINAL B** race track will be approximately 10 km long (no assistance area). It will include Hard Enduro EASY – MEDIUM sections.

#### Start:

Start will be at **09:00**, the competitors will start individually one (1) rider **every 10 seconds**, in the order of their qualifying results (best qualified first).

### Outside Help:

No outside help is allowed, neither from public nor from team members. Only riders can help each other.

#### Duration:

Race time stop after two (2) hours.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the two (2) hours will determine the classification.

#### Premature Race Stop:

If, by any motive, the race must be stopped, classification will be done as follows:

Less than half of the checkpoints raced – Race will be cancelled/Null

More than half of the checkpoints raced – Results will be determined by the number of checkpoints reached in the fastest time.

#### Classification:

Final results will be determined considering most laps and by the number of checkpoints reached in the fastest time.

All results will be available on a live timing platform.

# 5.3.2) Mitas Final A

Saturday's top **thirty (30)** qualified riders are qualified for the **LIQUI MOLY FINAL A** starting at **13:00** on Sunday.

Location: Abetone top station of Gondola (1953 slm.)

#### Track:

The race track will be approximately 31 km long and will have one Assistance Area.

# Start:

All competitors will start individually (one after another) with a defined time gap between riders, according to their position of their Saturday Straight Rhythm (16 riders) and Qualifying (14 riders) result/time.

#### **Start Time Gaps:**

Rider 1 to 17: 30s between each rider Rider 18 to 30: 10s between each rider

## Outside Help:

No outside help is allowed, neither from public nor from team members. Only riders can help each other.

#### Assistance Area:

Race track will have one Assistance Area where the teams can service, refuel, change wheels and repair the bike.

#### **GPS-Tracking:**

Every rider will have a GPS that must be validated in every checkpoint by a Marshall. If a checkpoint is missing the rider will be disqualified. If a rider doesn't deliver the GPS at the end of the race, he will be disqualified and he will need to pay 300 euro.

## Duration plan A:

# 2 laps

Rider that crosses first the finish line of the second lap is the Winner.

Maximum race time will be five (5) hours.

Maximum time for the first lap will be three (3) hours.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the five (5) hours will determine the classification.

#### Duration plan B (in case of bad weather):

#### 1 lap

Rider that crosses first the finish line of the first lap is the Winner.

Maximum race time will be five (5) hours.

Riders who cannot finish the race in time must return to the paddock by alternative route.

Last checkpoint registered inside the five (5) hours will determine the classification.

### Premature Race Stop:

If, by any motive, the race must be stopped, classification will be done as follows: Less than half of the checkpoints raced – Race will be cancelled/Null More than half of the checkpoints raced – Results will be determined by the number of checkpoints reached in the fastest time.

#### Classification:

Final results will be determined considering the number of Laps (2) PLAN A and Plan B one (1) lap and checkpoints reached. The rider with the most valid laps and checkpoint registrations in the right order and in the least amount of time will be the winner.
