Art. 4 - Participation/Eligible Riders:

- Off-road
- Off-road Elite
- Off-road One Event
- Speed Extension Off-road

Born in 2010 or earlier

FOREIGN RIDERS MUST HAVE:

1. An Italian License
2. A national license from a foreign federation affiliated with FIM Europe and a starting permission
3. A FIM EUROPE license and starting permission

Born in 2010 or earlier

Art. 5 - Classes and Motorcycles:

Motorcycles must comply with Art. 10, Title XI of the Enduro Sports Regulations.

Motorcycles with an engine capacity of less than 120cc are not allowed.

Category assignment will take place after the qualifications.

The top 40 riders will be divided into:

- Pro (Riders with World Championship points or in the top 5 of the Italian Extreme Enduro Championship Gold Category)
- Expert (Riders not in the Pro category)

Riders ranked 41st and below

The total of riders from 41st and below will be evenly divided into 4 categories, starting with Gold and descending in order to Iron:

- Gold
- Silver
- Bronze
- Iron

Tires:

Must comply with Art. 11.3, Title XIV.



Art. 6 - Registrations and Fees

Registrations must be made exclusively through the SIGMA - FMI Integrated Event Management System, paying the registration fee of €200 by October 18, 2024.

Art. 7 - Preliminary Operations

Will be conducted in ABETONE/VAL DI LUCE on October 18, 2024

- Administrative checks: from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM
- Technical checks: from 1:15 PM to 3:15 PM

Art. 8 - Program

8.1) Friday: Practice Day

- Free practice (not mandatory for the continuation of the event): 3:00 PM – 4:30 PM

8.2) Saturday: Qualifying Day

Q1+Q2+Q3

- Q1 and Q2 will be held on a Cross special stage
- Q3 will be held on an Enduro Country special stage
- Schedule based on the timetable
- One rider starts every 20 seconds
- Starting order based on race number
- Each rider will perform one timed run for each session (Q1 – Q2 – Q3)
- The qualifying standings will be determined by adding the times of the three test sessions
- The top 40 riders will advance to the Enduro Country semifinals
- Riders ranked 41st and below will go directly to the B FINAL of the Extreme Enduro on Sunday morning
- Riders with no time or missing a time will go directly to the B FINAL of the Extreme Enduro on Sunday morning

ENDURO COUNTRY:

- Duration: 6 minutes (both semifinals and final)
- 20 riders start in each of the 2 semifinals
- Semifinal composition based on the qualifying standings: semifinal 1 for riders in odd positions (1st - 3rd - 5th, etc.), semifinal 2 for riders in even positions (2nd - 4th - 6th, etc.)
- Starting position based on the qualifying standings
- Riders ranked 16th to 20th in each semifinal go directly to the B FINAL of the Extreme Enduro on Sunday morning
- Riders ranked 11th to 15th in each semifinal go directly to the A FINAL of the Extreme Enduro on Sunday afternoon
- The top 10 riders in each semifinal advance to the Enduro Country final and the A FINAL of the Extreme Enduro on Sunday afternoon
- Starting position for the Enduro Country final based on the semifinal standings

8.3) Sunday: Extreme Enduro Day

B FINAL:

- Schedule based on the timetable



- Duration: 2 hours
- 10 riders start in each row. One row every 40 seconds
- Starting order based on the Enduro Country semifinal placement for those who participated, followed by the qualifying standings
- All riders will receive a card that will be validated at each checkpoint

A FINAL:

- Schedule based on the timetable
- Duration: 2 hours
- Starting order based on the Enduro Country final placement for those who participated, followed by the Enduro Country semifinal placement
- 5 riders start in each row. One row every 20 seconds
- All riders will receive a card that will be validated at each checkpoint

Art. 9 - Awards and Standings

Riders registered in the national race will not earn points for the world championship.

The following categories will be awarded:

- Pro (Final A)
- Expert (Final A)
- Gold (Final B)
- Silver (Final B)
- Bronze (Final B)
